Basic Description: The project “Internet and Scientific Communication” explores the impact of a variety of internet technologies on how research is practiced and science is governed today. Our **focus** is on the diversity of scientific communication as a key institutional aspect of innovative science. Our **approach** is to explore possible trajectories by analyzing case studies of well-defined scientific production communities and identifying their style to embed (use) internet technologies and their diversity profile in the most relevant networks of scientific communication. Our **goal** is to typify trajectories and develop an understanding of the contextual constraints at work.
